



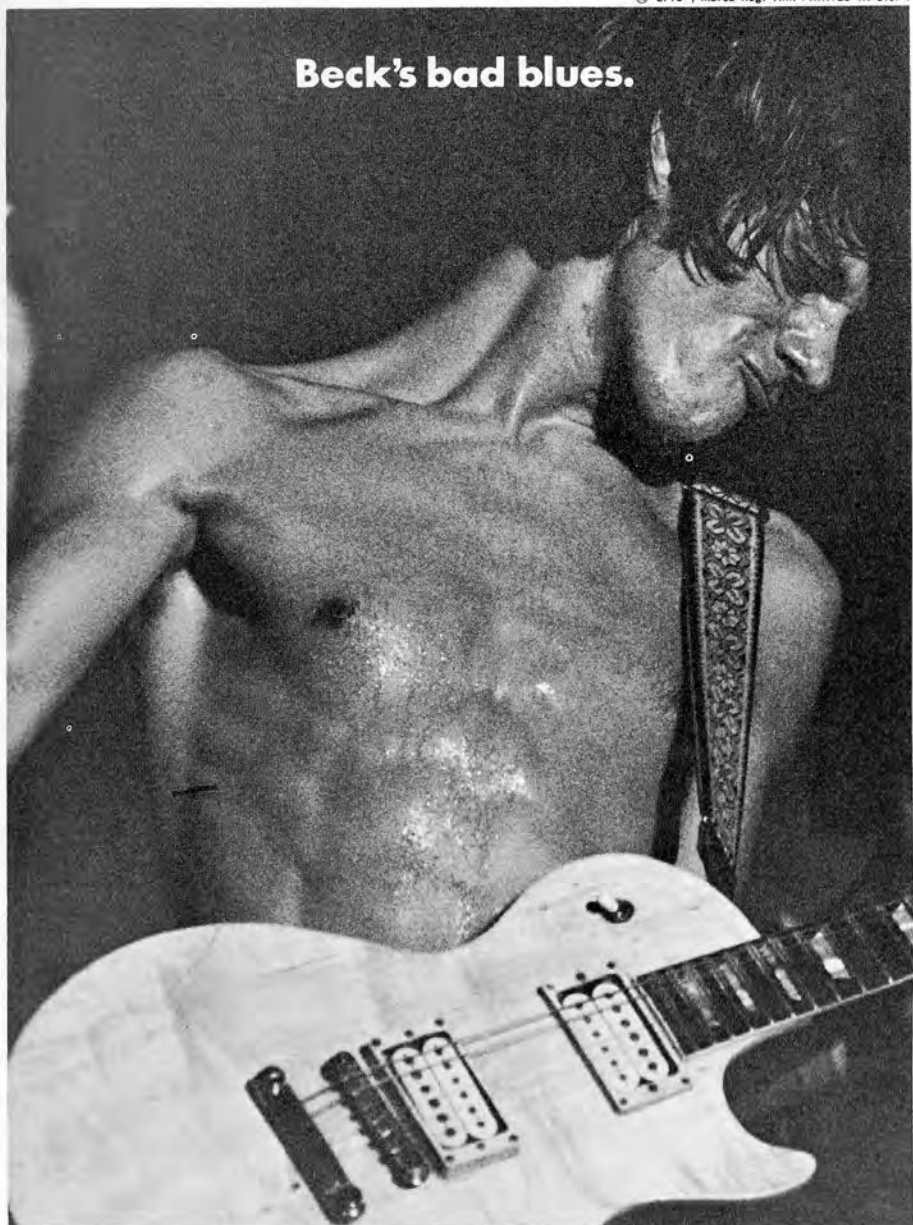

JEFF BECK GROUP

Headed by ex-Yardbird Jeff Beck, the Jeff Beck Group is returning to Fillmore East for the third time this weekend, having made a very successful American debut here last June. Beck (guitar) is responsible for penning many of the group's compositions, although they do interpretations of traditional blues tunes as well. The group's initial LP release, *Truth*, will be followed by a second album in the near future.

Nicky Hopkins (piano) originally played with the Cyril Davies Group, one of England's early blues bands. He has since established a reputation for his studio work, which includes record appearances with the Kinks, Rolling Stones and Beatles. Tony Newman (drums) is the newest member of the band, and has previously toured England with artists like Little Richard, Sam Cooke, and Jerry Lee Lewis. He also played for several years in a group called Sounds, Inc., and most recently taped a television special with Jerry Lee Lewis.

Ron Wood (bass) was formerly an art student and plays guitar and harmonica as well as bass. Rod Stewart (vocals) was once a solo performer, billed as "Rod the Mod." He has also been affiliated with Brian Auger and the Trinity and Long John Baldry's "Steam Packet."

The Beck Group will join several other British and American pop acts at this summer's Newport Jazz Festival.
